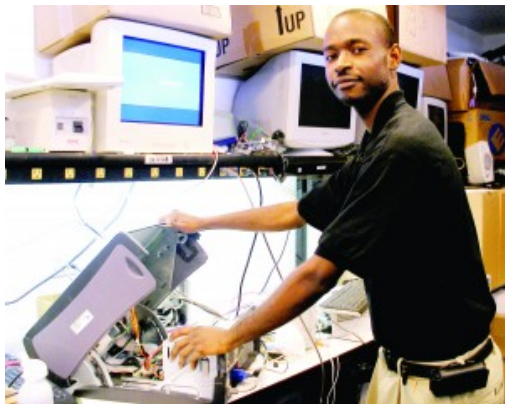
Thanks to OCCUR and the Stride Center, James Gibson III, a 26-year old Oaklander is now a computer technician making a great salary. The career move has changed his life.
